## ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 177, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE JEROME ZONING ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is desirable to require a fee for appealing decisions of the various Commissions and Boards of the Town;

AMENDMENT 1. Article 3, Section 302, E. Appeal - add the following in **bold** type:

Any person may file an appeal....regarding the granting, or denying, of use permits for a fee of \$100.

AMENDMENT 2. Article 3, Section 303, E. Appeals - add the following in **bold** type:

Any applicant for plan approval who is dissatisfied... may appeal... by filing a written notice of appeal <u>and payment of a fee</u> of \$100

AMENDMENT 3. Article 3, Section 304, G. Appeals - add the following in <u>bold</u> type:

Any applicant who is aggrieved... may pay a fee of \$100 and petition the Mayor...

WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this Ordinance Amendment is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, and to carry out the expressed intent and purpose of said Ordinance, Amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council.
